Monte Sereno Social Justice Award

Summary:

The Monte Sereno City Council in collaboration with the Monte Sereno Youth Commission created the Monte Sereno Social Justice Award program to establish an ongoing message for positive change regarding social justice matters in the greater City of Monte Sereno community. Submissions by local high school Juniors and Seniors will be reviewed annually in the month of May by the Monte Sereno Youth Commission.

The winner of the Monte Sereno Social Justice Award will be selected by the Monte Sereno Youth Commission and subsequently recognized at a Monte Sereno City Council meeting. One recipient will be chosen annually for the award. The City of Monte Sereno will issue a letter of recognition and a check for \$1,000 payable to a non-profit charitable organization selected by the awardee.

Vision Statement:

"The purpose of the Monte Sereno Social Justice Award Program is to establish an ongoing message for positive change regarding social justice in the greater Monte Sereno community by acknowledging students' efforts in creating a more equal and inclusive community."

Eligibility:

The Monte Sereno Social Justice Award is available to local high school students in the greater City of Monte Sereno area. Examples include Saratoga High School, Los Gatos High School, Westmont High School, Mitty High School, Presentation High School, Harker School, Saint Francis High School, Bellarmine High School, or others where residents of Monte Sereno attend high school presently or may attend high school in the future. To apply for award consideration, applicants must be a Junior or Senior in high school and maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA. Applicants must demonstrate a commitment to equality and social justice through active participation or leadership.
